Open Doors Article

I have submitted an extract from the Open Doors magazine in June regarding the importance that we Christians are charged with to pray for the lost, with particular reference to Muslims. A Christian convert from Islam is interviewed: Q: How has this experience changed you? A: When I came to Christ I felt a deep burden for my Muslim brothers who did not know this wonderful Christ that I had come to know. Q: So what can Christians do? A: The church needs to go on its knees and ask God to transform and bring Muslims to him, because we are all called to his kingdom. God sees their efforts to pray to him - but they do it in darkness, without knowledge of him. After I became a Christian, I met an old lady – she came over and hugged me and said 'I have been praying for you every time you walked into that mosque'. That will always stay on my heart, to know that my prayers can make a difference to somebody – it doesn't matter who it is. Like that lady, our prayers can and do make a difference too. Please make an effort to read the whole of the interview and join with the supporters of Open Doors in praying specifically during Ramadan for Muslims. The dates are August 11th – September 9th.
